Pendleton Cattle Baron's Weekend (PCBW) will be hosting a Leather Contest. The show and contest will run in conjunction with Pendleton Cattle Baron's Weekend, May 2nd-3rd, 2020.

This year's contest we are going to go back to the Tooled 5x7 inch piece of leather. No weigh requirements, no direction. Show us what you can do! From Traditional Floral to Geometric, to one of a kind, all will be accepted. This is not limited to just a 5x7 piece, but anything that meets that requirement. Examples could be a Rope Can, purse, briefcase; just let us know what portion of it you want judged for the contest! Judging will be strictly on the Tooling, not construction, etc.

Guidelines on Judging

Subject to change

All entered pieces will be judged in 5 different areas:

1. Uniqueness 10pts

What is the piece? Is it usable? Can you find this piece in your everyday store?

2. Difficulty 10pts

Is it a continuous pattern (tooling)? Does it have different flowers (tooling)? How much construction is involved? Time intensive?

3. Quality 10 pts

Is it made with quality material? Any short cuts taken?

4. Creativity 10pts

How much time and effort was put into the piece? Is it Cattle Barons or Cow/Horse industry related?

5. Overall Eye Appeal 10pts

Does it catch your eye when you walk by? Different colors used, etc.?
